

## **College Visits**

Students may request that college visit days be excused from the maximum absence limits. If the request is approved, these days will be designated as “college visit” (C).

College Visit forms may be obtained in the Attendance Office.

For seniors, all college visits must take place before Spring Break unless the visit is a required school orientation and/or if prior approval has been obtained from the Vice Principal, Director of Guidance and/or Supervisor of Students.

Students will not be eligible for excused college visit days if any of the following apply as determined by the Vice Principal, Director of Guidance or Supervisor of Students:

1. Student has a D or F in the previous marking period and/or any other significant academic concern.
2. Student has lost credit and/or is in position to lose credit for a course during the current school year.
3. Student has an unacceptable attendance/tardiness record and/or class cuts during the current school year.
4. Student has received disciplinary referrals during the current school year and/or has current disciplinary issues.
5. Student is currently ineligible for IDT privilege and/or has had IDT revoked during the current school year.
6. Student fails to have required signatures (Parent/Guardian, School Counselor, Attendance Secretary, and Vice Principal/Supervisor of Students) prior to visit.

Pursuant to N.J.4.C.6A:32-8.3, college visits (limited to a maximum of three days per year for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders) may be “excused”. Students may request college visit “C” days during the second semester of junior year and/or both semesters of senior year. Students may not exceed more than three college visit “C” days per year.
